# **BOARDS AND COMMITTEES**

## Airport Advisory Committee (AAC) – 2-year term

- Purpose: Recommend policies and programs to City Council for the Hillsdale Municipal Airport
- Eligibility: City residents, users of the Airport, knowledge and experience in either aviation or business.
- Meeting Frequency: Quarterly 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of January, April, July and October at 10:00 AM

# Board of Public Utilities (BPU) - 5-year term

- Purpose: Oversight for construction, maintenance, improvements, and extensions of the electric and water plants and distribution systems of the City.
- Eligibility: Business owners and BPU customers.
- Meeting Frequency: Monthly 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM

#### Board of Review – 2-year term, appointed every odd year

- Purpose: Review, hear and decide appeals of property tax assessments and some exemptions.
- Eligibility: Electors of the City, 2 of the 3 must be property taxpayers. May not be members of City Council or an immediate family member of the Assessor.
- Meeting Frequency: Tuesday following 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in March; 12 hours or more during the week of 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in March (usually Monday 9am-3pm and Tuesday 3pm-9pm); Tuesday following 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in July; Tuesday following 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in December

#### **Cemetery Board – 5-year term**

- Purpose: Advise on the care and management of the City cemeteries and direct improvements of the grounds.
- No special requirements for eligibility.
- Meeting Frequency: Quarterly 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of February, May, August and November at 2:00 PM

#### Dial-A-Ride Local Advisory Committee (LAC)

- Purpose: Recommendations for assessing, planning, and strengthening public transportation services.
- Eligibility: At least half must represent seniors and people with disabilities.
- Meeting Frequency: Annually

# Economic Development Corporation (EDC) and Brownfield Redevelopment Authority – 6-year term

- Purpose: Administer and oversee programs to alleviate and prevent unemployment, assist and retain local industries and commercial enterprises, and strengthen and revitalize the City's economy.
- Eligibility: Local business persons, property owners, and community stakeholders within the City.
- Meeting Frequency: Semi-monthly 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of month at 7:30 AM

#### **Election Commission – 1 year term**

- Purpose: Appoint Board of Election Inspectors for each precinct and other activities and duties relating to elections in the City.
- Eligibility: Qualified and registered electors of the City (not City officers or employees or nominees or candidates for elective City office).
- Meeting Frequency: As needed refer to annual election schedule published by the Michigan Secretary of State

# <u>Housing Commission – 5-year term</u>

- Purpose: Assist low-income families with safe, decent, and affordable housing opportunities.
- Eligibility: Concern for low-income housing needs, may be City employees.
- Meeting Frequency: Semi-monthly 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of month at 8:30 AM

# International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC) Appeals Board

- Purpose: Hear and decide appeals of decisions by the code official, notices, and orders issued under the IPMC.
- Eligibility: Experience and training pertaining to property maintenance, must not be a City employee.
- Meeting Frequency: As needed

## Library Board – 5-year term

- Purpose: Set policy, appellate responsibilities when necessary, and oversight of large-scale projects.
- No special requirements for eligibility.
- Meeting Frequency: Monthly 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday at 5:00 PM

#### Officer's Compensation Board – 5-year term

- Purpose: Determine salaries of all City elected officials.
- Eligibility: Registered voters of the City
- Meeting Frequency: Not more than 15 session days on every odd numbered year.

#### Planning Commission – 3-year term

- Purpose: Make recommendations to Council for adoption of the Master plan for the physical development of the City, as well as new and amended City ordinances; Review and approval or denial of site plans for proposed development projects.
- Eligibility: Qualified electors of the City.
- Meeting Frequency: Monthly 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday at 5:30 PM

#### **Shade Tree Commission**

- Purpose: Make decisions on tree-related matters throughout the City
- Eligibility: City residents or those who have a vested interest in Hillsdale
- Meeting Frequency: Quarterly 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of February, May, August and November at 3:00 PM

## Tax Increment Financing Authority (TIFA) – 4-year term

- Purpose: Promote economic and business development in the downtown central business district through administration of grants, programs and public improvement projects.
- Eligibility: Business persons, property owners, and community stakeholders within the TIFA district.
- Meeting Frequency: Semi-monthly 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday 7:30
   AM

#### **Zoning Board of Appeals – 3-year term**

- Purpose: Hear and decide appeals of decisions made by the Planning Commission and/or Zoning Administrator.
- Eligibility: City resident for at least one year with the ability to read and interpret codes and ordinances and an interest and/or knowledge of land use regulation and related issues.
- Meeting Frequency: As needed, at least once per year, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month

# **Election Inspector (poll worker)**

- Administer election procedures at the polling location on election day and/or for early voting (training and certification required and provided in advance); possibly additional office hours processing voter registrations and absentee ballot requests
- Eligibility: Michigan residents at least 16 years of age (registered to vote if 18+) with no felony or election crime convictions. Poll workers must be able to read and write and have good customer service skills.
- As needed refer to annual election schedule published by the Michigan Secretary of State
