**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that any qualified elector of the above mentioned Townships or Cities who are not already registered, may register to vote at the office of their respective Township or City Clerk, the office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agencies. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](http://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the Township or City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 21, 2024**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at their Township or City Clerk’s office during regular business hours, special pre-election weekend hours, or on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., as follows:

Candidates seeking election to the following nonpartisan offices are also to be voted for in your City or Township at the November 5, 2024 General Election: Justice of Supreme Court, Judge of Court of Appeals, Judge of Probate Court, City Council, Township Library Board Members, Village Council, Community College and School Board Members.
