Below is a list of the items cited during the meeting to review the plans of the proposed walking trail connection in Waterworks Park.

Present: Kristin Bauer (City Engineer), Alan Beeker (Planning & Zoning), Jake Hammel (DPS).

City Engineer

- Provide soil erosion control plan.
- Obtain SESC permit from County.

Public Services

- Maze entrance (similar to trail railroad crossing at Montgomery St.) with fencing on either side to edges of trail property.
- Retaining Wall?
- Screen trees installed on park side of new fence
- Trail in park must meet ADA compliance.
- AASHTO Signage along trail required
- Trail in park to be 3-3.5" HMA with 6" stone base
- 15' min. radius at trail intersection
- 10' wide trail width in park.
- 30' min. landing area at base of slope to have a max. grade of 2.5%.
- Required Use Agreement inclusions:
 - Development HOA or Owner to be responsible for all installation and maintenance costs.
 - O City to reserve right to close or restrict trail connection should breach of the agreement occur or the trail falls into disrepair
 - o Any alterations or additions to trail connection subject to City review and approval
 - o If Development HOA or Owner wishes to abandon trail connection at any time in future, HOA or Owner to be responsible for 100% of removal costs.
- Require an recorded Easement on City property.

Planning/Zoning
